MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum 13: Use of Non-Tactical Vehicles (TMP)

1. References.

a. Army Regulation 58-1, *Management, Acquisition, and Use of Motor Vehicles*, 28 January 2000.

b. USAREUR Regulation 58-1, *Management, Acquisition, and Use of Nontactical Vehicles*, 27 January 2003.

2. Nontactical vehicles (NTVs) are all commercial-type vehicles assigned to 121 Signal Battalion by 417th TMP. In accordance with the references, the Battalion Commander alone authorizes the uses of NTVs in 121 Signal Battalion. Daily use of battalion NTVs is managed by the battalion CSM. Daily use of G6 TMPs is managed by the G6 SGM.

3. Normal use of NTVs will consist of the following:

a. Transportation to and from a normal place of duty to official events, ceremonies, promotions, or training.

b. Transportation to and from the normal place of duty for Division G6 soldiers (Kitzingen to Wuerzburg) once per day each way, as a group, and with a designated leader present.

c. Movement of official or personal mail, distribution, parts, and personnel to and from training areas in support of training events.

4. Transportation to and from commercial transportation locations (i.e. airports) must be approved by the commander on a case-by-case basis and is restricted to the following:

a. Emergency leave transportation to commercial transportation sites.

b. Official travel transportation (TDY) to commercial transportation sites.

c. Sponsors picking up newly arriving soldiers at commercial transportation sites.

5. NTVs may not be parked at PXs, shopettes, commissaries, bowling alleys, or clubs unless official events or duty requirements mandate the presence of 121 soldiers at those locations.

6. NTVs will not be used for personal business at any time.
