- e. Has the unit conducted a mask fitting of all personnel with the M41 PATS?
- f. Has the unit appointed the following personnel on orders.
  - (1) NBC Officer
  - (2) NBC NCO ( if not a 54B )
  - (3) Enlisted Alternate
- ◆g. Are the following qualified IAW V Corp Reg 350-4 chapter 3, para 2, section A. personnel 2 wks Division NBC School or 54B BNCOC?
  - (1) NBC Officer
  - (2) NBC NCO
  - (3) Enlisted Alternate

**Note: At least two personnel must fit the qualification under Reg V Corp Reg 350-4 or automatic failure will result for the section.**

h. Does the unit maintain a mask board or unit roster which reflect the following:

- (1) Type of mask
- (2) Size of mask
- (3) Date mask was fitted/tested (PATS)
- (4) Canister lot numbers
- (5) Date canisters were installed
- (6) Individual Protective Equipment (IPE) sizing data for BDOs , JSLIST, overboots, and gloves
- (7) Optical inserts: required/on-hand/on-order

Does NBC NCO have a CDE assist user login and password?</li> <li>b. Are all personnel assigned to the unit inputed into CDE Assist? (Check using alpha roster)</li> <li>c. Is equipment inputed into CDE Assist? ( Check one piece from each type in section D.)</li> </ul>
