Is BN tracking company IPE? d. Does the BDE/BN have a program to ensure units are tracking shelf-life items and ordering the replacement items NLT 90 days prior to expiration? e. Does the BN have a copy of its shortages list and are the items on order? f. Are file copies of the BDE/BN NBC Equipment/ IPE expenditures on hand. g. Does the BDE/BN have copies of the last reported CDE report. h. Is the BDE/BN tracking unit TMDE and RATTTS IAW V Corp Reg 50-3.</p> <p>Training:</p> <p>a. Are the subordinate control parties (i.e. BN & Co) being certified IAW V Corps Reg. 350-4 b. Is there a BDE/BN program for ensuring companies are certifying NBC equipment operators IAW V Corp Reg 350-4 Para 3-5. c. Does the BDE/BN ensure the NBC tasks are being integrated into all training exercise sceneries lasting longer than 72 hours? (Training Schedules) d. Do BDE/BN with aviation unit crewmembers perform STX in full MOPP for a minimum of one hour?</p> <p>NBC Annex: Does the NBC Annex to the unit's tactical SOP include the following:</p> <p>a. Responsibilities of the unit commander, NBC Officer, NBC NCO, NBC Enlisted Alternate, equipment operators and individuals. (IAW 350-4 Par 4-2 a). b. Alarms and warnings (general, local, sound and approved visual signs). c. Procedures for establishing MOPP, to include procedures for wear of M9 paper and individual identification while wearing BDOs. d. Procedures for NBC Force Protection (i.e. decon, recon, smoke, NBC sampling operations, CDE emplacement, etc). e. Priorities for decon based on the unit's mission and commander's guidance. f.
