Is a class given on accident avoidance? c. *Are soldiers road tested using Appendix G of AR 600-55 (PMCS test/vehicle control test/on-the-road test)? d. Do company commanders have a sustainment training program? e. Is the sustainment program conducted annually? f. Do 1st line supervisors conduct annual check rides? g. FOR OPERATORS OF VEHICLES WITH AIR BRAKES: Is a class and test given on air brake operation prior to licensing? <p>4. Night Vision Device (NVD) Training: (2 pts each total = 16 pts)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Are NVD instructors certified by the commander in writing? b. Are NVD instructors current on NVDs and qualified on the vehicle used to teach the class? c. *Does the unit follow the POI found in TC 21-305-2 in its entirety? (written test/PMCS with NVD/Phase I,II,III driving and road test) 		
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- d. *Is the road test circuit composition and length (variety of road conditions and terrain/ about 10KM in length) as outlined in Appendix D of TC 21-305-2?
- e. Has the commander established speed limits for all NVD missions?
- f. Are risk assessments done for all NVD missions?
- g. Is refresher training conducted for those operators who have not participated in an NVD mission within the last six months? (AR 600-55 para 8-6)
- h. Is refresher training IAW AR 600-55 Appendix I?

5. Automated Records (1 pt each – total = 16 pts)

- a. Are DA Forms 5983-E available for all soldiers issued an operators permit (DA Form 5984-E)? (AR 600-55)
- b. Do instructors and examiners have their qualifications entered in the description section of DA Form 5983-E? (AR 600-55)
- c. Are there any family of vehicle equipment class codes, that are not model / noun specific, used on DA Form 5983-Es? (AR 600-55)
- d. Has the commander and operator signed the DA Form 5984-E? (AR 600-55)
- e. Have equipment operators received winter drivers training (minimum of 1 time on their tour, for all personnel licensed prior to December of the previous year)? (UR Supp 1 to AR 600-55)
- f. Is the winter drivers training annotated on the DA Form 5983-E? (UR Supp 1 to AR 600-55)
- g. Are personnel trained and licensed on bottled gases, stoves, steam cleaners, etc.? (AR 600-55)
- h. Does the DA 5983-E have “License Issued” in the qualifications section of the operators qualification record? (ULLS End Users Manual and DA Pam 738-750)
- i. Are all entries except “LI” shown in the code description block entered in the description section of the DA Form 5983-E, for each vehicle training conducted, AR 385-55 training and initial testing? IAW (Ar 600-55, UR PAM 190-4-1 or 2)
- j. Have any licenses expired on the DA Form 5983-E? (AR 600-55, ULLS End Users Manual)
- k. Are NVD qualifications entered on DA Form 5938?
- l. Does the unit have the Air Brake Test on file for persons licensed on vehicles equipped with Air Brakes? (V Corp Policy Letter, TC 21-305-100)
- m. Have annual check drive on equipment been recorded in the description block of DA Form 5983-E? (IAW AR 600-55)
- n. Are all of the Haz Cgo vehicles operators, hazardous cargo trained and is their certification valid (not expired)? (UR 55-4)
- o. Do Haz Cgo operators have an “ADR Card” and a certificate of training on hand? (For operators not available, a photocopy of ADR card and Certificate of Training on hand.) (UR 55-4)
- p. Have fuel handlers been issued DD Form 1902 (Fuel Handlers Permit), if they are driving fuel carrying vehicles? (FM 10-69)
