United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) Handbook for Emergencies.</li> </ol> <p>B. Discussion:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Civil-Military Operations (CMO) includes five missions: Population and Resources Control; Foreign Nation Support (FNS); Humanitarian Assistance; Military Civil Assistance; and Civil Defense. CMO objectives include the following: Minimizing civilian interference with military operations; reducing the negative impact of military operations on the civilian population and the environment; obtaining civilian cooperation and support for military operations to facilitate mission accomplishment; supporting US, NATO, or Joint Coalition objectives and policies; and deconflicting operations of, maintaining interactive relations with, and harmonizing the goals and objectives of international, national, and private organizations and agencies operating within the Area of Responsibility (AOR). CMO occurs throughout the battlefield (i.e., close, rear, and deep) and is an integral part of the fight in or near populated areas. Rear areas often contain potential FNS (e.g., supplies, facilities, services, and labor resources) that US commanders can use to support military operations.</li> <li>2. 1ID conducts CMO to enhance its military effectiveness. CMO must be integrated IAW METT-TC into unit plans and operations during all phases of the Military Decision Making Process (MDMP). This includes the designation and assignment of a unit S5, establishment of a CMO element during deployments and training exercises (including CMTC), and planning for the attachment of active or reserve component Civil Affairs (CA) personnel. Unit CMO activities also include planning and coordinating the use of FNS. Units must assess the impact of a civilian populace with 1ID's AOR as well as how Dislocated Civilians (DCs) may affect maneuver and other operations. Units must ensure CMO reporting is IAW the 1ID TACSOP. Commanders must be aware of their moral and legal responsibilities toward the civilian population.</li> </ol>
